**A299 CLIFFSEND ROUNDABOUT,
HENGIST WAY, RAMSGATE**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow works to be carried out to improve roundabout signage for safety reasons, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on a section of A299 Cliffsend Roundabout, Hengist Way, Ramsgate.

Off-peak closures are planned from Monday 6 August 2018 for up to 2 days, between 09:30 hours and approximately 15:00 hours each day.

Cliffsend Roundabout will be closed to westbound traffic at its southern junction, between the southbound and northbound carriageways of Hengist Way.

The alternative route for any through traffic is by continuing southbound on A299 Hengist Way to Sevenscore Roundabout and then northbound.
