A299 HENGIST WAY, MINSTER

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER SEPTEMBER 2018

To allow works to be carried out to apply additional road markings for improved safety, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A299 Hengist Way, Minster, Ramsgate

Overnight closures are planned from Monday 3 September 2018 for up to 2 nights, from 19:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

A299 Hengist Way will be closed in both directions between Minster Roundabout and Cliffsend Roundabout.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via B2190 Minster Road, Spitfire Way, B2050 Manston Road, A256 Haine Road and A299 Lord of the Manor Interchange back to Hengist Way.
