(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of B2014 Newington Road & B2050 Manston Road, St Lawrence, Ramsgate.

Overnight closures are planned from Sunday 2 September 2018 for up to 3 nights, from 19:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

B2014 Newington Road will be closed from the junction with High Street St Lawrence to a point north of the railway line.

B2050 Manston Road will be closed in the vicinity of the roundabout junction with Newington Road

The overall alternative route for all through traffic is via A256 Haine Road, A299 Lord of the Manor Interchange, A299 / A255 Canterbury Road West, A255 Nethercourt Hill, High Street St Lawrence, Park Road and A254 Margate Road

Access to the remainder of Newington Road continues from Margate Road direction, with access to Manston Road from Haine Road direction.
