B2050 MANSTON ROAD, BIRCHINGTON

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow safe access to the overhead phone cable network to enable repairs to a damaged telegraph pole to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2050 Manston Road, Acol, near Birchington.

Off-peak closures are planned from Monday 15 October 2018 for up to 2 days, between 09:30 hours and approximately 15:30 hours each day.

B2050 Manston Road will be closed between the junctions with Acol Hill and Shottendane Road.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via Acol Hill, The Street (Acol), Minster Road and B2190 Spitfire Way back to Manston Road.

Margate Hill will be closed at the junction with Manston Road and can be accessed from the Acol direction.
